Hamas International Financing Prevention Act



Overview:

The H.R. 340 bill proposes imposing sanctions on foreign individuals or entities aiding designated Palestinian terrorist organizations like Hamas and Palestinian Islamic Jihad. It intends to **block** these groups' **access to international support networks and opposes the use of goods, including medicine**, for facilitating **acts of terrorism against Israel**. The bill outlines specific prohibited activities, triggering sanctions such as asset blocking and trade limitations, while also requiring regular reports to Congress on global efforts to disrupt the financial activities of these terrorist organizations.
