







Representative

After clicking on the add new comment button on the top right of the app, a section will open up that will allow you to add the text. It will then show up like normal.









React




Hamas International Financing
Prevention Act



Overview:

The H.R. 340 bill proposes imposing sanctions on foreign individuals or entities aiding designated Palestinian terrorist organizations like Hamas and Palestinian Islamic Jihad. It intends to block these groups' access to international support networks and opposes the use of goods, including medicine, for facilitating acts of terrorism against Israel. The bill outlines specific prohibited activities, triggering sanctions such as asset blocking and trade limitations, while also requiring regular reports to Congress on global efforts to disrupt the financial activities of these terrorist organizations.

118th Congress (2023-2025)

Passed House on Nov 1, 2023 This bill passed in the House on November 1, 2023 and goes to the Senate next for consideration.

37% chance of being enacted






Horizontal Prototype
